Vesta is a service for families and citizens that allows to be active in person, by hosting refugees at home, in a structured and supervised project.

Migration of asylum seekers is a social phenomenon that nowadays involves everyone in different ways.

Vesta aims to offer citizens the opportunity to contribute to the development of a new model of integration.

Vesta wants to be a means through which families and citizens open their doors to others, and share with their guests their relational system. Through relational activities our communities enhance and develop inclusion and integration.

Vesta is an additional and complementary part of the national system SPRAR - System of Protection for Asylum Seekers and Refugees. It committed to diversifying the range of possibilities available to Municipalities and Organisations in welcoming asylum seekers on their territory.

VESTA: REFUGEES AT HOME – HOW VESTA WORKS

- It collects and organises applications from families
- It manages all the steps of the hospitality process, by means of a staff composed of social workers and psychologists from Camelot with more than ten years of experience in the field. In particular, it sustains the families in all the legal, psychological and bureaucratic aspects of the reception process to ensure a safe and clear development
- It supervises the hospitality process thanks to a feedback system from the families and the hosted asylum seekers and refugees; while improving the services offered.
- It links all the people involved in the project through a social community.

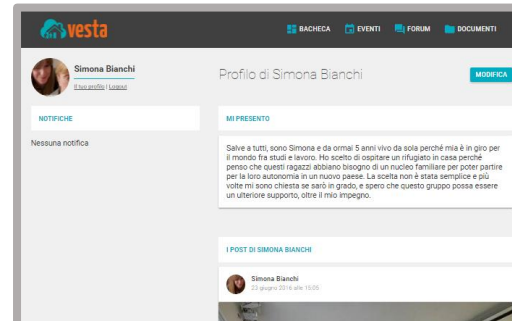
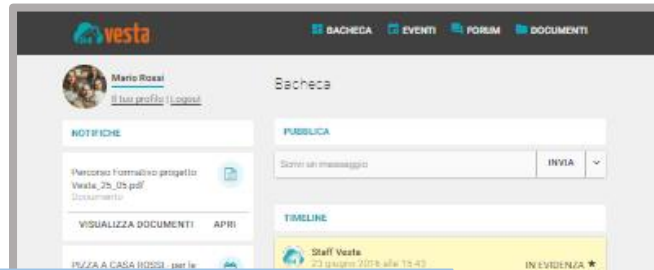

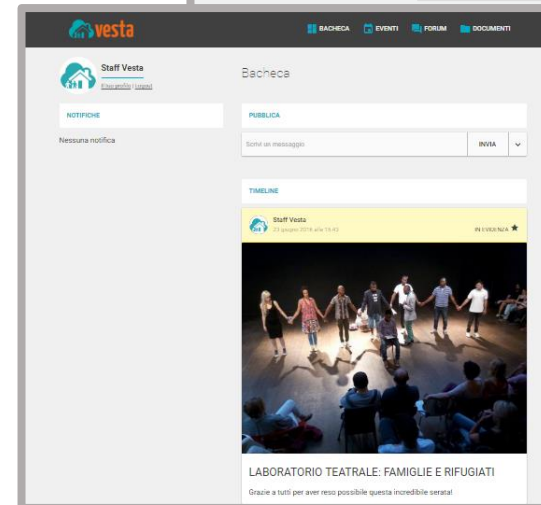
